TOTAL \$328,813 BUDGET St. George CCSD #258 strives to provide a safe and secure learning environment for all students at all times. In addition to a Safe Return to School Plan, the District has created an ARP ESSER Use of Funds Plan.

The updated Return to School Plan for the 2022-2023 school year has the district following the CDC recommendations (not mandates) to the best extent possible. This plan is attached in the Safe Return Tab of the application. Mitigation strategies are still in place and daily hygiene is stressed to students and staff daily.

The breakdown above are sources of federal funding and summaries associated with expenditures that aided in the re-opening of our school and addressed the issues students and staff faced with the ongoing pandemic. Expenditures will be consistent with CDC guidance in an effort to provide a safe learning environment for all students while addressing the academic impact of lost instructional time due to the pandemic.

The LEA provided a survey for stakeholders (parents, teachers, board members, teachers, administration) by which input regarding the utilization of funds was given. This survey allowed for input by stakeholders to be provided, reviewed and utilized and appropriate. The district plans to have Reading and Math jump start for the beginning of the FY23 school year. Transportation will be offered so every child will have the opportunity to attend. Also, any new program implemented will be shared with the public along with the purpose, goals, timeline and etc. of the new programs. This plan will be reviewed at a minimum of every 6 months in order to update as needed. Along with the academic piece, social work services will be provided throughout the school year to assist students and families impacted by the pandemic.
