

Returning the Chromebook

Failure to return when school resumes or when directed by Administration.

- Charged the full replacement cost
- Stolen property report may be filed with the local law agency
- Failure to pay submitted to collection agency

Caring for the Chromebook

Responsible for general care Email SGChromebooks@sg258.org Never taken to outside Never leave unattended for siblings to use/play with

General Precautions

No food or drink should be next to Chromebooks.

Cords and cables must be inserted carefully into Chromebooks.

Chromebooks should not be used or stored near pets.

Chromebooks should not be used with the power cord plugged in when the cord may be a tripping hazard.

Chromebooks must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, and labels.

Care and Carrying

Heavy objects should never be placed on top of Chromebooks.

The issued protective sleeve should be used whenever the Chromebook is being transported or not in use.

Never lift Chromebook by the screen.

Never carry the Chromebook with the screen open.

Screen Care

Do not put pressure on the top of a Chromebook when it is closed.

Do not store a Chromebook with the screen open.

Do not place anything in the protective sleeve that will press against the cover.

Make sure there is nothing on the keyboard before closing the lid (e.g. pens, pencils, or disks).

Only clean the screen with a soft, **dry** microfiber cloth or anti-static cloth.

Asset Tags

All Chromebooks are labeled with a District asset tag.

Asset tags may not be modified or tampered with in any way.

Students may be charged up to the full replacement cost of a Chromebook for tampering with a District asset tag or turning in a Chromebook without a District asset tag

Backgrounds & Themes

Inappropriate media may not be used as Chromebook backgrounds or themes.

The presence of such media will result in disciplinary action.

School Issued Google Apps for Education Account log-in NEVER share account passwords with others, unless requested by administrator

Managing and Saving Work

Cloud Based

Majority of work is cloud based and accessible from any computer with Internet connection

Save and save frequently when necessary

School is NOT responsible for loss of any student work


Operating System and Security

Automatic
No need for
manual
updates

DO NOT pating install or use system other than the current version of ChromeOS

Data encryption and verified boot
No need for additional virus protection
